179th GUNNER SAPPER CRICKET MATCH at CHATHAM, 15-17 JUN 10

1. The 176th Gunner Sapper cricket match will be played at Chatham from Thu 15 to Sat 17 Jul 2010. The three day game will be preceded with a squad training afternoon at Larkhill on Wed 14 Jul before travelling to Chatham where overnight accommodation will be provided.

2. Gunner Cricket has had a relatively successful season reaching the semi-finals of the EDF Inter-Corps Competition. There are, however, three remaining fixtures, the most significant of which is the three-day match against our fiercest rivals. The Gunners have won the match, and thus retained the trophy, since 2007 and the chain of command is encouraged to support this fixture and ensure the strongest possible team can be selected for our continued success.

4. Players are to report to the Reggie Hudson Pavilion, Larkhill, at 1400hrs for training and nets. The squad will then travel to Chatham, where accommodation will be provided for the duration of the fixture. The squad will be hosted throughout the fixture by RECC and will be expected to attend functions

post play on Thu and Fri. Dress requirements for the fixture will include Blazer/Tie (Gunner) and RACC Polo shirt. A playing shirt will also be provided.

5. Players are reminded it is their responsibility to confirm their availability to the Secretary RACC as soon as possible. If for any reason a player is unable to attend, the chain of command is also asked to inform the Chairman RACC in the first instance.

6. Travel/Transport. Please endeavour to share transport where possible. Your travel expenses – hire car, air, rail and road travel for attending the match qualifies as conditions of Service travel for Representative sport. You should show this letter to your travel booking authority who must show your UIN on any warrants etc but quoting the IAC to be charged as IEI 1403 POT 16. POT 16 must be used in order to access IAC IEI 1403 and the costs involved are attributed to AG's TLB. IAC 1403 can only be charged to the programme costs budget and the costs shown against this IAC cannot be charged to individual Unit's UINs.

7. The Gunners have had dominance in this annual fixture for the past few seasons. The chain of command is requested to support the squad to ensure we retain the trophy and achieve victory away from home to culminate the 2010 season on a high.
